

Winner's Circle Scholarship Application

The Winner's Circle Scholarship program is designed to reward leadership in SCAAEP and to help offset the escalating costs of veterinary education and minimize debt load at graduation by providing financial aid to students in their 4th year of veterinary school.

These \$1,500 scholarships will benefit deserving students through a partnership between the AAEP Foundation and The Race For Education, as well as with the support of Platinum Performance.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must;

- be a National AAEP student member and active within their school's AAEP chapter;
- currently attending an AVMA Accredited College of Veterinary Medicine with a foundation chapter;
- Apply during their 3rd year (7th-9th semesters) for funding during their 4th year (final year) of veterinary curriculum.

Supporting materials that must accompany a completed application and submitted to Your student chapter advisor by February 12th include:

1. Essay on the following topic:

What sets you apart from other veterinary students and how will you impact the field of equine veterinary medicine? (Maximum of 750 words.);

2. Brief description of career goals that addresses the following:

What area of equine practice do you plan to focus on? Please describe what steps you will take over the next 5 to 10 years to gain the experience and skills to become an expert in these areas. (Maximum of 750 words.);

- 3. Two signed letters of recommendation (seal can be broken);
- 4. Current official transcript (seal can be broken);
- **5. Financial Need Verification Form** (found at the end of this application);
- **6. Award letter (s)** for other scholarships, if applicable.

*All scholarships are \$1,500 unless recipient qualifies for the Assets for Independence (AFI) Federal grant program available through The Race For Education. If a student meets Federal guidelines and completes the grant program, the student receives the \$1,000 scholarship for the fall term then as part of the grant program receives an additional \$4,000 in grant funding for their spring term. Extensive information about the program is provided after scholarship recipients are notified of selection committee's decisions in May. The AFI program only open to US residents.

Assets for Independence Grant Program
The Race For Education offers additional funds through the Race For Education/ Administration for Children & Families Assets for Independence grant program (AFI). Eligible scholarship recipients agree to reach a savings goal of \$500 in an individual development savings account in their name at a specified bank over a period of 6-8 months. In return, the federal government's AFI program and The Race For Education will match that with \$2,000 each (for a total of \$4,000). The student's savings, the matching funds, and any interest that has accrued, is the student's but must be used to pay college expenses and is sent directly to their school. Applications accepted through February 26, 2016



The Winner's Circle Scholarship, awarded through a partnership between the Race for Education, AAEP Foundation and Platinum Performance, is awarded to incoming 4th year vet students.

All students applications must be submitted to their chapter advisors by <u>February 12th</u> and each chapter advisor is to forward their <u>TOP THREE</u> applications to <u>The Race for Education</u>, postmarked by the <u>February 26th</u>.

To be eligible for this scholarship, a student must;

- Be a National AAEP student member and active within their school's AAEP chapter;
- Currently attending an AVMA Accredited College of Veterinary Medicine with a foundation chapter;
- Apply during their 3rd year (7th-9th semesters) for funding during their 4th year (final year) of veterinary curriculum.

Each chapter advisor is to submit their <u>TOP THREE</u> applicants to <u>The Race for Education</u>, <u>1818 Versailles Road Lexington</u>, <u>KY 40504</u>, <u>postmarked by 2/26/16</u>. Those three applicants are then reviewed by the RFE and AAEP Selection Committee and a Winner Circle Scholarship recipient is chosen from each chapter. If you feel that you have more than three deserving applicants, please feel free to forward no more than four applications.

All scholarships are \$1,500 unless the applicant qualifies for the Assets for Independence (AFI) Federal grant program available through The Race For Education. If a student meets Federal guidelines and completes the grant program, the student receives the \$1,000 scholarship for the fall term then as part of the grant program receives an additional \$4,000 in grant funding for their spring term. Extensive information about the program is provided after applicants are notified of selection committee's decisions in May. The AFI program is open to US residents only. All students who apply for the Winners Circle Scholarship will be automatically eligible for the Race for Educations AFI Program.

Although, some applicants will not be chosen to receive the Winner's Circle Scholarship; they may be eligible to participate in the AFI program based on their financial need.

I would encourage your students to fill out the AFI paperwork attached to the Winner's Circle application. There is no selection process. It is all based on the students financial need.

All applicants will be notified by May 2, 2016.
